AUDITORS' REPORT

To the Council and Members, The Students' Society of McGill University.

We have examined the balance sheet of The Students' Society of McGill University as at June 30, 1973 and the statements of revenue and expenditure and surplus for the year then ended. Our examination included a general review of the accounting procedures and such tests of accounting records and other supporting evidence as we considered necessary in the circumstances.

Our examination of cash receipts, because of their nature, was limited to comparisons of recorded receipts with bank deposits.

In our opinion these financial statements present fairly the financial position of the Society as at June 30, 1973 and the results of its operations for the year then ended, in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles applied, after giving retroactive effect to the change in the method of accounting for fixed assets referred to in note 1 to the financial statements, on a basis consistent with that of the preceding year.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 1973

1. RETROACTIVE CHANGE IN ACCOUNTING FOR FIXED ASSETS

In prior years, the society followed a policy of writing off fixed assets in the year in which they were acquired. During the current year, the society changed to a policy of capitalizing fixed assets and depreciating them on a straight line basis over their estimated useful life.

Accordingly, the surplus as at June 30, 1971 has been restated to give effect to the recording of fixed assets at a cost of \$26,156 less accumulated depreciation of \$11,776. The statement of revenue and expenditure for 1972 reflects the capitalizing of fixed assets, purchases of \$1,700 and depreciation of all fixed assets of \$3,878.

As a result of this change, the excess of expenditure for the current year has been reduced by \$10,179.

3. McGILL STUDENTS' HOUSING CORPORATION LOAN

In 1969 the McGill Students' Housing Corporation entered into an agreement with McGill University whereby the University agreed to lend the sum of \$500,000 to the McGill Students' Housing Corporation for the purpose of interim financing of construction of a students' residence. The Students' Society of McGill University, as a party to the agreement, guaranteed all obligations incurred therein by the corporation.

Funds of approximately \$312,350 were advanced to the corporation before plans to construct the residence were abandoned. McGill University assumed title to the property and credited the corporation with \$210,000 leaving a balance due of \$102,350. The property was subsequently sold by McGill University for approximately \$175,000.

McGILL STUDENTS' HOUSING CORPORATION LOAN (cont'd)

To date no formal agreement has been negotiated between the Students' Society and McGill University, but the parties have agreed by letter that the loss to be absorbed by the Society amounts to \$73,223 and is payable in annual instalments of \$13,770 terminating in 1976, with interest at 5%%. The instalments will be deducted at source from students' activity fees collected by McGill University for the Society.

4. CONTINGENT LIABILITIES AND LONG-TERM COMMITMENTS

(i) The Students' Society has agreed to pay Radio McGill Inc. \$76,000 to cover the cost of operating a fully licensed F.M. radio outlet. This amount is payable in equal instalments over four years from the date Radio McGill Inc. is granted a broadcast licence.

The application for a licence is currently under review by the Canadian Radio and Television Commission.

- (ii) Equipment rentals totalling approximately \$6,500 per annum are payable under long-term leases expiring in June 1978.
- (iii) The Students' Society is the defendant in a law suit by Lyons Food Caterers Ltd. in the amount of \$42,000. In the opinion of legal counsel for the Society no provision for the payment of this amount is required.
