Motion Regarding Amendments to Bylaw II-4, Article 4.1

Whereas, SSMU's legal advisors have recommended a change to our policy on clubs signing contracts/written agreements because of the potentially huge liabilities it opens us up to,

Whereas, the spirit of bylaw II-4 article 4.1 is in this direction but still allows for potentially dangerous contracts to be signed by clubs,

Whereas, this procedure needs to be clear for clubs,

Resolved, the current Bylaw II-4-4.1 be replaced with the following edited version:

4.1 Chief financial officers of SSMU Clubs shall submit all potential contracts **involving any monetary** value **or obligations on the part of the Club** to the Vice President Clubs and Services for evaluation before signing the contract. The Vice President Clubs and Services shall evaluate the legal and financial soundness of the contract **with the advice of the General Manager** and return it to group in an expedient manner.
