



Motion Regarding TaCEQ Reform

Whereas, TaCEQ is undergoing a process of reform to better serve its members, and will be discussing this in depth at its General Assembly in May;

Whereas, a survey was sent out to SSMU Councillors for feedback about the role that TaCEQ should play, campaign and research focuses, and priorities for the coming year;

Whereas, a question was included regarding whether TaCEQ's documents should be bilingual;

Whereas, a total of 12 responses were received;

Resolved, that the SSMU bring the following recommendations for TaCEQ reform:

That if TaCEQ is to commission research, research in to international and out of province student issues, the funding of universities, financial aid, the quality of programs and university governance be some of the top research priorities

That if TaCEQ is to engage in campaigns for the coming year, the topics of international needs, changes to university governance, alternatives to tuition and changes to university financing be some of the top priorities

That TaCEQ's organizational priorities for the year should be to increase awareness of who TaCEQ is, improve communication to its members, continue to be part of the "chantiers" from the Summit and share existing research among member associations

That TaCEQ make its documents available in both French and English.
