Facebook message - Regarding Building Centre Fee Referendum

I posted a message on Facebook in the Engineering Undergraduate Society with the intention of informing everyone of the recently referendum regarding the SSMU Building Centre fee. I apologize for some misleading information that I posted, but luckily the main message still got across. A lot of students approached me afterwards asking me questions such as "Why is the building centre fee not incorporated into the SSMU base fee?"

Also, another student told me that the reason why voted against the referendum is because SSMU never informed the students beforehand of a Building Centre Fee and all of a sudden this question popped up on the referendum. A lot of students were unaware of such fee, and not sure where it came from and why it is here and what it will be used for, hence voting against the referendum. He thought that if SSMU had informed the students better what the fee is used for, then the referendum would have a much better turnout. I have personally reflected on this issue and blame it on my lack of duty as a councilor on failing to properly inform my constituents of the fee before its appearance on the referendum. On the other hand, I believe my peer Councillor Rioux has done a considerably better job on informing EUS councilors of the referendum question. To make up it, I tried to explain to the students about next year's referendum on the same issue in Fall 2014, where I advised them to think carefully about the issue before voting on it.

An advice for future councilors would be to: Announce the referendum questions to your constituents on Facebook before the elections, go through each of them and really explain to your constituents what each referendum concerns, and how it affects them.

- Our last crossover meeting is happening this Tuesday April 8.


