THE PROJECTS


Redpath Group Study Zone Expansion (\$277,145)

- Addition of 105 electrified seats with USB jack + comfy seating areas.
- 24 new computers
- Lounge areas with multiple seating options

McLennan Additions (16,352)


- Thanks AUS for the proposal!

- Various projects across Library's branches
