Product Form:

- "The Unofficial McGill Students' Guide, herein referred to as "the Guide" is an online resource (www.UnofficialMcGillGuide.com). The Guide provides information to help prospective and current McGill students navigate the complexities of student life at McGill. In addition, the Guide attempts to take information provided by the official McGill website and make it more accessible to students, often by adding advice and personal experience. For example, along with instructions for course registration, the Guide provides reassurance to students that they shouldn't panic if they don't immediately get into all their courses, and gives tips and advice for how to handle waitlists and registration errors. Moreover, the Guide provides resources and information about the McGill and greater Montreal community."

Recommendation: Reject

The Interest Group Committee recommends that Unofficial McGill Students Guide be rejected for Full Status based on their score of 22/30 on the Full Status Approval Rubric.

McGill Students Chapter of the Canadian Liver Foundation
