### Report of the President to Legislative Council

11<sup>th</sup> of March, 2015

#### **Student Democracy & Constituencies**

- Judicial Board
  - GA JBoard Case:
    - Received recommendations. Uploaded reference doc to vibe from Jboard
      - Considering that the J-Board must respect the principles of natural justice, equity, and good conscience in its interpretation and application of the By-Laws and Constitution, the Jboard concludes this recommendation as follows: the J-Board finds a positive obligation on the part of SSMU Legislative Council to create, publicize and bring to all General Assemblies a set of standing rules that promote an effective and accessible process for students as stated in article 5.2 of SSMU By-Law I-5. In order to make a recommendation for the second question, the Jboard found it necessary to distinguish between standing rules and rules of procedure. The distinction between these two sets of rules aims to clarify the point that the special 2/3 majority to pass a Motion to Postpone Indefinitely is not a standing rule at all, but rather a rule of procedure, and therefore does not represent a valid exercise of power on the part of the SSMU Council in establishing standing rules for General Assemblies under Articles 5.2 and 5.2.2 of SSMU By-Law I-


#### **McGill Governance & Relations**


