Motion Regarding the Increase in the Radio CKUT Fee for the Fall 2015 Referendum

WHEREAS, the CKUT is a campus-community radio station operating out of McGill University, broadcasting at 90.3 on the FM band to the greater Montreal area and internationally online;

WHEREAS, the CKUT features music, news, arts, culture, and spoken word programming by McGill students and for McGill students;

WHEREAS, the CKUT provides hands-on experiential learning and internship opportunities to students interested in sound recording, production, journalism, and broadcasting;

WHEREAS, the CKUT employs McGill undergraduate students, includes McGill undergraduate students on its Board of Directors, and grants voting rights to all undergraduate fee-paying students;

WHEREAS, the CKUT is consistently recognized as one of the best radio stations in Montreal by CultMTL;¹

WHEREAS, the CKUT's current annual budget for 2015-2016 is attached as "Appendix A – CKUT Budget";

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the SSMU Legislative Council approve the following question for the 2015 SSMU Fall Referendum Period:

"Do you agree to increase the Radio CKUT fee by \$1.50 per student per semester, payable and opt-outable on Minerva by all undergraduate students who are members of the SSMU, for Winter 2016 until Winter 2021 (inclusive), resulting in the following fee schedule:

\$6.50 for full-time SSMU members in faculties other than Law, Dentistry, and Medicine \$5.50 for full-time SSMU members in the faculties of Law, Dentistry, and Medicine \$4.50 for part-time SSMU members in faculties other than Law, Dentistry, and Medicine \$4.00 for part-time SSMU members in the faculties of Law, Dentistry, and Medicine"

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the CKUT's annual budget, attached as Appendix A, be included with the referendum ballot.
