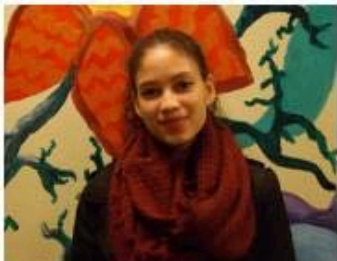

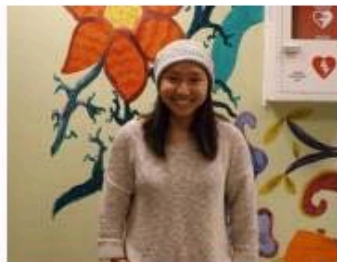

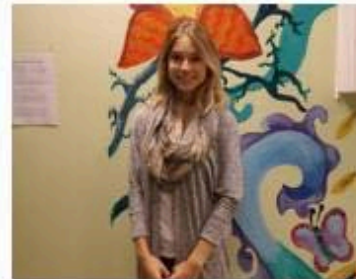


Alison Gu

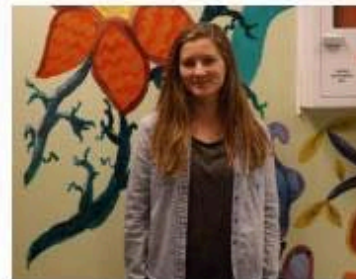
