Goals:

The External affairs committee has endeavored to restructure the accessible education policy, inform the membership of issues pertaining to provincial representation, and research provincial austerity measures.

Progress:

Thus far, the external affairs committee has done preliminary research on items related to austerity at McGill and solutions to austerity. We've then decided to focus on our efforts on modifying the accessible education policy and expanding on the points that were passed in referendum last semester.

Issues:

The external affairs committee is a particularly difficult committee because of its especially broad mandate. Both members at large that originally applied have dropped out because they weren't aware of the obligations of the committee. In addition, many of the mandates can be taken on by alternative bodies, such as the McGill Against Austerity campaign team and the provincial representation taskforce.
