- Expanding Communications: The Committee recognizes that SSMU needs to reach out to students in the way that is most accessible this can be achieved through the Committee using new communications platforms like snapchat to reach out to SSMU members.
- ➤ Online Consultation: The Committee will be taking on the implementation of the opt-in consultation next semester.
- ➤ Clarifying Accountability Structures: The Committee is interested in developing resources outlining the channels for students to make complaints and to make change within the SSMU examples include the development of infographics about the internal SSMU structure and how to navigate it.
- Information Dissemination: The Committee would like to actively reach out to first year students and collaborate with residences in order to provide information to students who may be less aware of SSMU and the services that the SSMU operates. There is also interest in the development of a short video series as part of a "Know Your SSMU" campaign to be planned next semester.
