Notice of Motion Regarding the Amendment of the Internal Regulations of the Presidential Portfolio

WHEREAS, the definition of "campaigning" is housed in the Internal Regulations of the Presidential Portfolio (IR-01);

WHEREAS, "campaigning" is currently defined as "any activity that promotes the candidacy of a Member standing for Election;"

WHEREAS, by this definition, any activities to encourage students to vote for or against a referendum question are not considered campaigning;

WHEREAS, this narrow definition that excludes campaigning for referenda means that referendum committees are not subject to many of the campaign regulations;

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the definition of "campaigning" in the Internal Regulations of the Presidential Portfolio be amended to read as follows:

(g) "Campaigning" shall mean any activity that encourages Members to vote for or against a candidate or a referendum question.
