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- I have received some concerns about the Listservs length by PSSA which I am trying to address by sending out a larger listserv this week.
- Utile Campaign and Press release statistics are very positive. When released at the same time as the listserv, they do hurt my listserv numbers but ultimately still have a higher read rate than any other liststserv of the previous year.
- SQ- Was recommended to wait for a fix for the next Listservs, I determined that it
 was the length of the listserv that caused the problem. As January has a lot of
 events for the semester, lots of events had submitted posts for the listserv and I
 tried to include as many of them as possible. Unfortunately this resulted in the
 blocking of the listserv.
- SQ- I've now limited the listserv to seven entries a week to avoid this problem.
 Hopefully this improves the current rate of blocking listservs.
- SQ- Sent an email to Jon Nordland to assess an fix this issue for next semester referencing what
- SQ Spam Filter (Listserv #6, #12, #14, #15)
 - Listserv #12 is almost completely blocked to all members
 - Possibly due to the new McGill anti-phishing email sent out on November 11th
 - Called McGill IT for a fix, they were not helpful.
 - Ryan provided me with an old list of things to avoid in the Listserv to ensure successful delivery, so I browsed through the Listserv and fixed all the problems that I thought I might run into. It was fixed and managed to be sent out to everyone!
