#### **BUILDING AFFAIRS**

- Implementation of B.O.M. Com Projects:

- What's new?
  - o 12 new courses are being offered this semester
  - o We've developed a comprehensive and attractive new website → ssmu.ca/minicourses
  - o New promotional materials and unified branding scheme
- 90% of courses have already broken even with 1 week left in registration (registration is strong)
  - o Registration ends Friday January 20th, courses begin the week of the 23rd
- The MiniCourses team now runs on slack, and as a result we're much faster responding to issues

# **SUSTAINABILITY**

- SPOKES Planning:
  - o SPOKES conference scheduled for Saturday, February 4<sup>th</sup>! → Save the date
- Waste-Management Taskforce:
  - o The number of buildings that compost on campus will be increasing in the fall 2017. SSMU will be included in a pilot project to create a standardized composting plan
  - Other interesting initiatives include processes to better handle hazardous waste + to better recycle lab plastics
  - o JOB OFFER → the taskforce will be hiring a student staff to help develop the McGill University campus-wide waste management master plan. Contact VP-OP for more details

#### • Garden Project

o Meetings will resume next week, and will be led by Environment Committee Member Jess DiBartolomeo, who has volunteered to be the new team lead



o Next meeting we'll be choosing our final vegetable list, finalizing our timeline, and creating a tentative crop map sketch

## **CAMPUS SPACE PLANNING**

- Construction Timelines:
  - o Construction to resume on Sherbrooke as of Monday (January 16<sup>th</sup>)
    - ONLY 1 lane eastbound until March
    - Expect route changes to the 24 and the 107
  - o Heavy construction to continue on McTavish until May 2017
  - o Construction beginning this week on Leacock terrace until September 2017
- Construction updates:
  - o Accessibility issues near Service point and by the S1 door of SSMU have been addressed, and we're awaiting a response from the contractor
  - o Continue to report any issues to the VP-OP ( <u>operations@ssmu.ca</u> ) and they will be brought up with both liaison officers and SNC Lavalin and McGill officials

# **MISCELANEOUS**

- Indigenous Art Project:
  - o Met with Wendy Owens of the visual art collection to talk about logistics for procuring and maintaining art in the building
  - o Based on feedback we've gotten from the proposal, we're considering procuring prints rather than originals, which would be easier to protect and would be easier to insure
  - o More consultations with Indigenous students still needs to be done to determine what art would be selected and where it would be placed in the building
  - o We're still aiming for a March deadline to have this project up-and-running
- Activities Night: Gave out 2,000 free cupcakes, 8 liters of free coffee, and 100 free espressos in 8 hours over the two days of Activities Night
