BUILDING AFFAIRS

- Implementation of B.O.M. Com Projects:
 - o Project implementation continues
 - o Allocation of remainder of space fee
- Building Space audit
 - o Work begins this week. Focus = space breakdown by group type, analytics on flow
- Worked with the Porters to coordinate the implementation of new Club Lockers

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Sadie's Student-Run Café

- OneCard:
 - o Negotiations continue, however we're still waiting on McGill to submit us a contract.
 - o [Tentative] Goal = have OneCard readers by the end of February
- Re-branding implementation:
 - o Check out the 2nd floor elevator
- We're now offering \$1.25 coffee if you bring your own 12 oz mug



SUSTAINABILITY

- **SPOKES:** The SPOKES conference ran successfully this past Saturday, attendance of around 50
- Waste-Management Taskforce:
 - o Work begins to implement composting in the SSMU building by September, 2017
 - I've met with a representative from facilities to explain the logistical challenges of our building and to plan the necessary steps.
 - We've determined that the logistics of implementing composting are relatively simple; the challenge is to develop a thorough education campaign to get high-quality compost
- Garden Project
 - We've developed a comprehensive map of which vegetables we're going to grow and where. Next: get protocol on how to grow them
 - Work order is submitted to McGill, we're waiting to hear back for a timeline
- SSMU Handbook:
 - Next-year's student handbook will be sustainability-themed. Our vision is to have our handbooks made with 100% recyclable paper and to include a number of ways students can get involved with sustainability on campus (using the infographic from last semester)
- Interfaculty Sustainability Council
 - Goal = Increase collaboration between sustainability groups on campus, to reduce duplication of labor, and to align resources when necessary
 - o Reached out to faculties to organize a cross-campus student council on sustainability
 - o Aim = have our first meeting by the end of February
 - This initiative has become increasingly important, and it is now my #1 priority

CAMPUS SPACE PLANNING

- Leacock Terrace (facing SSMU):
 - o McGill is planning a redevelopment of this space.
 - o Message <u>operations@ssmu.ca</u> if you're interested in being part of a focus group

MISCELANEOUS


- Indigenous Art Project:
