# **CLUBS**

- I've been having weekly meetings with the Clubs and Services Administrative Assistant over the course of the summer and entering into the school year.
  - o All Student Group Information Form processing, Club Bank Account Form processing, and general inquiries can be directed to the Club Administrative Assistant.
- The Club Commissioner and I will also be holding weekly meetings throughout the school year in addition to working on the Club Committee together.
