McGill Policy Against Sexual Violence

- Discussed draft <u>Policy Against Sexual Violence</u> at October 19th Senate meeting, including <u>initial</u> <u>proposed revisions & SSMU-PGSS consultation report</u>
- Recommendation meetings with Dean of Students (October 17th), Provost & Associate Provost (October 24th), unions & associations (October 28th), external consultants (November 3rd & 4th)
- Attending Partners Meeting for <u>major SSHRC research project</u> addressing sexual violence on university campuses (November 4th-5th)

McGill Ad-Hoc Committee to Review the Charter of Student Rights

- SQ Priorities include stronger language on accommodations, disability & intersectionality; ensuring consistency with other policies; improving students' awareness of their rights
- Met on Thursday, October 27th to begin revising "fundamental rights" section

Unpaid Internships Policy

- Presented background context to Legislative Council on Thursday, Octoer 20th
