### Overview

- > Committee met eight times this semester
- Deadline was set for January 30th this semester
  - Applications for this semester and the summer
    - o Going through the applications received by the deadline took longer than anticipated
      - Fewer number of applications this semester than historically received
        - Quorum was a major hurdle this semester
        - Councillors need to be held more accountable
- Attempting to give more feedback to groups with their applications
- Deadline for second installments April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015
  - Extensions granted on a case-by-case basis groups are asked to contact me by the 15<sup>th</sup>
  - o No report → no second installment

### **Quick Stats**

- > Total **new** applications for the semester: 132
  - Approved: 117
  - Rejected: 13
  - Most applications had at least a request from one Fund granted.

#### **Fund Highlights**

Α

- Club Fund
  - Total amount requested \$68,311.96
  - Zeros were considered
  - After the allocations for applications from the Winter deadline, the CF was reduced from its initial value of \$86,000 and the Committee later decided to stop allocating from the CF altogether
- > Campus Life Fund
  - Total amount requested \$74,952.74
  - CF applications received after January 30<sup>th</sup> were taken out of the CLF
  - QPIRG's Social Justice Days was not given its previously contracted \$1500
- Ambassador Fund
  - Total amount requested \$103,789.23
  - Fund is completely drained for this semester



Funding Committee Report

- Huge applications were pooled together and the remaining funds just split evenly across all of them
- New this academic year: individuals were funded for academic trips
  - Overall, it's a good change since funding for such trips are usually scarce while placing a huge financial burden on the attendees.
  - Problem: How much funding is too much for one person?
- Space Fund
  - Total amount requested \$5,312.86
  - Drained
  - Main project: funding the glass walls for the Chemical Engineering Students' Society's common room
- Green Fund
  - Total amount requested \$11,448.35
  - Not very heavily requested; still accepting applications
  - Engineering Design Teams are now required to do educational outreach for sustainability/the environment
    - Much thanks to the McGill Formula Electric for their cooperation
- Equity Fund
  - Total amount requested \$14,443.75
  - Drained
    - Hip-Hop Week was granted a total of \$2300 from the EF
      - Initial decision was \$1000, but it was decided to give most of the year-end balance (\$1300) to
        off-set the deficit racked up by the organizers.
- Charity Fund

- Total amount requested \$29,641.42
- Drained
- Lots of "fundraising" applications but some good community initiative requests
  - The Committee would prefer that this Fund be more focused on community initiatives
    - Potentially restrict fundraising applications?
    - Need to communicate to students that there's more to community involvement than throwing money at a problem and calling it a day.
- First Year Council Fund
  - Total amount requested \$1,895.75
  - A few requests most were rejected for not fitting the Fund's mandate
  - Need to publicize this a lot more.

### Installments System

- > Deadline for submission: April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015
- Groups who asked for the remaining 60% to be released early were evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
   Needed to provide reason and proof of urgency
- Problems for groups who were suddenly faced with liquidity issues hopefully now that they're aware, things will be smoother next year
  - Major problems for groups who are not running "events" (i.e., no specific end date for project)
  - Formally institute mechanism for this
  - Redesign form so it's more general some confusion for groups who don't run "events"
- Had workshops/drop-in sessions last week
  - 6 hours; ~5 people dropped by (sigh)
  - Did get some feedback from groups about what funding fails at will pass those along to my successor
- Despite the problems, the system has helped in minimizing "over-funding"
  - Groups have voluntarily returned their funding even after they were informed of a successful application
  - Some groups received less than the remaining 60% (with some not receiving any at all)
- > Expecting the fund balances to go up by a bit
