

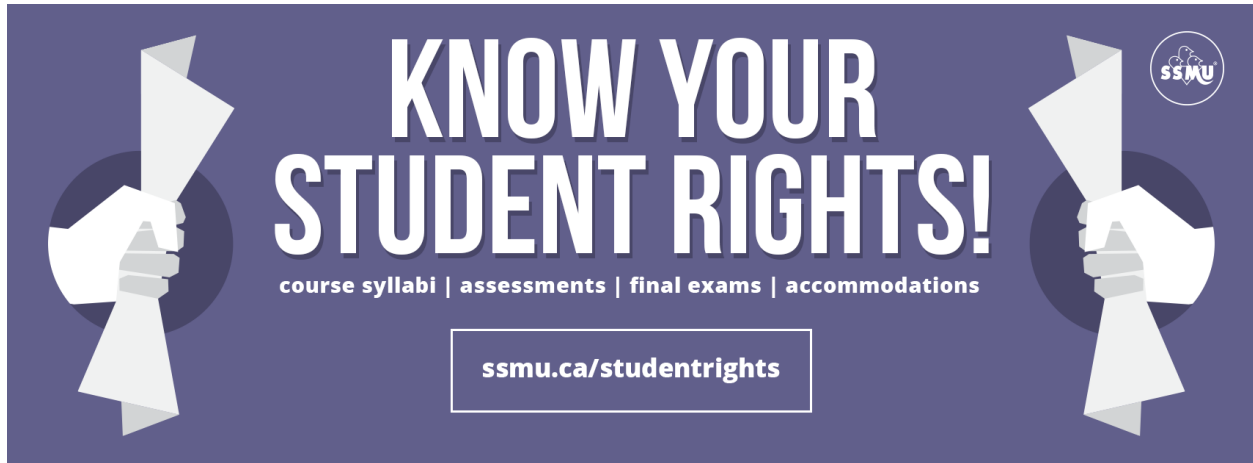

- Finalizing timeline of policy history & proposal for campus study of existing policies (next term)
- Sexual Violence Protocol Working Group meeting on December 13th
- Meeting with Associate Provost, Harm Reduction Coordinator, Dean of Students & PGSS Equity Commissioner on December 20th to discuss implementation priorities

McGill Ad-Hoc Committee to Review the Charter of Student Rights

- Received response to Senate question regarding McGill regulation of unpaid internships on November 23rd; will be advocating for more consistent evaluation framework across McGill
- Submitted December Senate question regarding Faculty internship programs; advocating for elimination of course fees & introduction of academic credit for internship terms & co-ops
- Will now be bringing forward *SSMU Policy against Unpaid Internships* for consultation in January
