- Meeting with Associate Provost, Harm Reduction Coordinator, Dean of Students & PGSS Equity Commissioner on December 20th to discuss implementation priorities

McGill Ad-Hoc Committee to Review the Charter of Student Rights

- Met on Tuesday, November 29th to discuss fundamental rights section & begin revisions
- Next meeting TBD in mid-December

Unpaid Internships Policy



- Received response to Senate question regarding McGill regulation of unpaid internships on November 23rd; will be advocating for more consistent evaluation framework across McGill
- Submitted December Senate question regarding Faculty internship programs; advocating for elimination of course fees & introduction of academic credit for internship terms & co-ops
- Will now be bringing forward SSMU *Policy against Unpaid Internships* for consultation in January

- Met with Co-President of Universities Allied for Essential Medicines (UAEM) regarding Global Access to Medicines Policy & strategy timeline for Intellectual Property Policy revisions
- Scheduling meeting with Associate Vice-Principal (Innovation) regarding IP Policy revisions
