
Academic Advocacy

 - The focus was on tabling which took place at Activities Night and different buildings on campus
 - Teamed up with Student Advocacy (Branch of the Legal Information Clinic) to host a Know Your (academic) rights ama.
 - Pamphlets on student-prof relationships
 - Moved the 3rd annual academic summit to next semester in order to schedule it in time with advocacy projects on campus and to engage the student body on discussions around a fall reading break.

- Right to Campus has published a toolkit on staying safe at Mcgill.


