WHEREAS, the Services Review Committee has determined that the resources provided by a SSMU Service should be offered to all SSMU members free of charge, which would be financially unfeasible for Organic Campus if they would to remain a SSMU Service;

WHEREAS, the granting of Independent Student Group status to Organic Campus would allow for Organic Campus to continue sales of local and organic food in the University Centre without requiring any structural or operational change to Organic Campus;

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the Service Status of Organic Campus be revoked;

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT Organic Campus be granted Independent Student Group status.
