



Motion Regarding the Service Status of the McGill International Students' Network

WHEREAS, the McGill International Students Network is a SSMU Service that provides programming to international students;

WHEREAS, the programming of the McGill International Students' Network focuses primarily on hosting social events and trips both within and outside of Canada;

WHEREAS, student groups that focus on social activities such as events and trips typically hold Club status, and student groups that focus on resource provision typically hold Service status;

WHEREAS, the McGill International Students' Network fails to meet the definition of a Service as outlined in the Internal Regulations of the Clubs and Services Portfolio, as determined by the Services Review Committee;¹

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the Service Status of the McGill International Students' Network be revoked;

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the McGill International Students' Network be granted Full Club Status.
