# **UNIVERSITY & ACADEMIC AFFAIRS**

### **SENATE & UNIVERSITY RELATIONS**

### Senate

- Senate met on Wednesday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>:
  - o Discussed budget plan, student aid, Strategic Enrolment Management, graduate studies issues & proposed revisions to *Policy on Intellectual Property*
  - o Provost has allocated \$500K towards 2017-18 Indigenous initiatives (\$2.3 mil over 5 years)
  - Vice-Principal (Research & Innovation) committed to including humanitarian licensing principles in upcoming commercialization guidelines (Fall 2017 timeline)
- Next Senate meeting on Thursday, April 20<sup>th</sup>:
  - o Discussing proposed budget, revised *Charter of Students' Rights*, implementation of *Policy against Sexual Violence*, campus construction projects, Student Life & Learning report
  - o Voting on revised *Policy on Intellectual Property* & Strategic Academic Plan 2017-2022
  - o Submitting questions on university responses to Islamophobia & student diversity
- Legislative Council approved revisions to Internal Regulations of Representation & Advocacy that will now automatically delegate senator elections to Faculty associations

### McGill Ad-Hoc Committee to Review the Charter of Students' Rights

- Revised Charter will come to Senate for information in April & approval in May; committee will meet to review feedback following April meeting
- Looking into best ways to address issues with "McGill context" jurisdiction

• Final policy coming to April Senate for approval; Associate Vice-Principal striking working group to develop commercialization guidelines (with humanitarian licensing principles) for Fall 2017

- Met with SEDE Family Resources Coordinator on Tuesday, March 28<sup>th</sup> to discuss revising Guidelines for the Accommodation of Pregnant Students and Students Caring for Dependents

- Graphic designer has created draft flowchart poster on academic accommodations
- Will be finalizing University Affairs Committee changes to student rights website & discussing future possibilities with incoming VP University Affairs
