Personal

Clubs, Services & ISGs

Activities Night – To be frank, Activities Night was kind of a mixed bag. Due to a number of reasons, attendance was low: poor advertising strategy on SSMU's part, a very successful Fall Activities Night (people were already so involved), and the cold weather, of course. At the same time, the new format was exciting and engaging, and I think should be done again in future years. I will have some serious recommendations for my successor. Room Bookings System Project – I'm really happy with the progress of this project. The SSMU IT Manager and I have been meeting weekly with the developer. We want the program to be essentially perfect when we launch it, so it takes a lot of nitpicking. It will also be SUCH a labour-saver when it's implemented, which will mean our front desk staff will be less burdened.

CKUT – I will disclose that being on the board lately has been a bit rough for a lot of personal reasons. Besides that, there is the difficult situation of the referendum - both the J Board case and Mendelson's refusal to implement the results of the question has meant a lot of tough decision making. At the time of writing CKUT has yet to come to its decision as to its next steps. Obviously it depends a lot on the events of the next couple of weeks.

MOA and Name Changes – I sent all related receipts (from clubs and services) to McGill on January 17. Soon we will be reimbursed for expenses related to name changes. We are still waiting for name confirmations from McGill. We've been a bit distracted, to say the least.

Services – Thanks to VP Patel for a review of the SSMU Services' financials. I will be setting up individual meetings with members of the SSMU services to discuss the first half of the year and how things are going.



Committees


