Priorities:

- 1. Clearly define the role of committees
- 2. Increase Accountability
- 3. Reduce number of committees for optimal function
- 4. Define appropriate size of membership
- 5. Determine proper ratio of Councilors to SSMU Members

Research:

Much of the work already done has been analyzing the committee structures in other Student Unions across Canada. We have started analyzing trends, and documenting the most effective features. Right now, we have mostly seen schools from Western Canada. Namely, UVic, UBC, Simon Fraser, UAb, Manitoba, Sasketchewan, and Brock University.

March: Final Draft of plan, Bring to Council for Final Approval
