Resolution Regarding the Protection of the Long Term Integrity of the SSMU

**WHEREAS** necessity is the mother of invention or re-invention as the case may be, and;

**WHEREAS** the long-term integrity of the society should be protected with regards to the SSMU's Constitution and By-Laws, and;

**WHEREAS** the Constitutional Review Committee (CRC) is charged with duty of maintaining the long-term integrity of the society with regards to its Constitution and By-Laws (By-Law I-6), and;

WHEREAS a Constitutional Review Committee currently does not exist, and;

**WHEREAS** the current lack of a Constitutional Review Committee leaves the Constitution and By-Laws vulnerable to changes that may compromise the long term integrity of the society, and;

**WHEREAS** the SSMU's Constitution and By-Laws charge the President with the duty of maintaining the long-term integrity of the SSMU (Article 10.3 of the Constitution and By-law I-6), and;

**WHEREAS** the Constitutional Review Committee falls under the Presidential portfolio.

**THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED** that the Presidential Affairs Committee (PAC) be charged with the duties that would ordinarily be carried out by the Constitutional Review Committee until such a committee is constituted or the review of committees' structure is finalized.
