Dear Candidate,

Our Elections McGill team would like to extend to you a warm welcome to the 2011 Senate Caucus Elections! There are 13 undergraduate seats on the Senate Caucus, two of which are reserved for the SSMU President and VP University Affairs, the remaining positions available for election are the following:

Arts(2) Education

Science Management

Medicine Dentistry

Law Music

Engineering Religious Studies

Only undergraduate students in good standing at McGill and who will be returning to McGill for the 2011-2012 academic year are eligible to run.

Please fill out all of the attached documents in this package and read the documents here stipulated, to complete your candidacy, by following all of the following steps:

- 1. Collect signatures from the lesser of either 50 individuals or 25% of those in your faculty, who are undergraduate students and who wish to support your candidacy, by asking them to fill out the enclosed nomination form. (*Note: you might want to include extra signatures to ensure all of the required ones are valid)
- 2. Where required, fill out your personal information, print your name as you want it to appear in the ballot, and sign the attestation of academic standing.
- 3. Email us an electronic copy of your 100-word statement (Optional).
- 4. Email us a passport-sized digital photo of yourself in jpeg format (photos larger than passport-sized will be resized at our discretion).
- 5. Submit this completed kit any time before 5:00 PM on Monday, February 28th, 2011, by dropping it off at our office. We are located at 3480 McTavish, room 405, in the University Centre (Shatner). Late forms will be rejected without appeal.
- 6. Make sure that an Elections McGill officer signs this document in the appropriate form. You might wish to photocopy this kit for your personal records before handing it in.
- 7. Attend the mandatory candidates meeting on Monday February 28th, at 6:00 PM (location TBA). At this meeting you will get a chance to meet the Elections McGill Officers and find out

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how the election works. More importantly, we will explain the Elections By-Laws, as well as the rules, procedures and possible sanctions that are applicable.

8. Elections McGill requires that all candidates carry themselves in full respect of the Constitution and By-laws of the SSMU. The officers of Elections McGill are specially charged to maintain good electoral decorum and enforce campaign violation regulations. Please read the electoral by-laws and relevant constitution articles found at www.electionsmcgill.ca under the Regulations tab.
