Resolution Regarding By-law Changes

WHEREAS the long-term integrity of the society should be protected with regards to the society's constitution and by-laws, and;

WHEREAS a Constitutional Review Committee currently does not exist, and;

WHEREAS three days is not enough time for councilors to look through by-law changes and ensure they are consistent with existing by-laws and do not compromise SSMU's long term integrity, and;

WHEREAS by-law changes are hardly ever urgent;

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED that section 10.2 of By-Laws Book 1-2 be amended to read:

10.2 No resolution may be placed before Council, which has not been distributed to the Councilors three (3) days in advance of the meeting at which it is to be debated without leave of Council. Resolutions that seek to change council by-laws will be distributed to councilors fourteen (14) days before they are presented before council for debate.
