Dear Candidate,

Our Elections SSMU team would like to extend to you a warm welcome to the 2012 Senate Caucus Elections! There are 13 undergraduate seats on the Senate Caucus, two of which are reserved for the SSMU President and VP University Affairs, the remaining positions available for election are the following:

Arts(2)	Education
Science	Management
Medicine	Dentistry
Law	Music
Engineering	Religious Studies

Only undergraduate students in good standing at McGill and who will be returning to McGill for the 2012-2013 academic year are eligible to run.

Please fill out all of the attached documents in this package and read the documents here stipulated, to complete your candidacy, by following all of the following steps:

1. Collect signatures from the lesser of either 50 individuals or 25% of those in your faculty, who are undergraduate students and who wish to support your candidacy, by asking them to fill out the enclosed nomination form. (*Note: you might want to include extra signatures to ensure all of the required ones are valid)

2. Where required, fill out your personal information, print your name as you want it to appear in the ballot, and sign the attestation of academic standing.

3. Email us an electronic copy of your 100-word statement (Optional). More details will be provided on a later page.

4. Submit this completed kit any time before **5:00pm** on **Monday, February 27, 2012**, by dropping it off at our office. We are located at 3480 McTavish, room 405, in the University Centre (Shatner Building). **Late forms will be rejected without appeal.**

5. Make sure that an Elections SSMU officer signs this document in the appropriate form. You might wish to photocopy this kit for your personal records before handing it in.

6. Attend the mandatory candidates' meeting on Thursday, March 1, 2012 from 4:00-6:00pm in room 302 of the University Centre (Shatner Building). At this meeting you will get

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a chance to meet the Elections SSMU Officers and find out how the election works. More importantly, we will explain the Elections By-Laws, as well as the rules, procedures and possible sanctions that are applicable.

7. Elections SSMU requires that all candidates carry themselves in full respect of the Constitution and By-laws of the SSMU. The officers of Elections McGill are specially charged to maintain good electoral decorum and enforce campaign violation regulations. - Campaign Period: Monday, March 5, 2012 at 9:00am to Wednesday, March 14, 2012 at 9:00am
 - Please be aware that prospective candidates may not begin campaigning until the campaign period begins. Violation of this rule will result in sanction.
- Polling Period: Thursday, March 8, 2012 at 9:00am- Wednesday, March 14, 2012 at 5:00pm
- Announcement of results: Wednesday, March 14, 2012 at Gert's...approximately 6:00pm (or earlier)
