



Motion Regarding an Exceptional Referendum Period

Whereas, Article 25.4 of the SSMU Constitution regarding Referenda outlines that “Council may define exception referendum periods by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote”

Whereas, Article 25.5 of the SSMU Constitution reads: “Referenda to raise ancillary fees or create new ancillary fees shall be held in the Fall referendum period except in the case of council-initiated exceptional referendum periods as per Article 25.4;”

Whereas, there are currently three proposed Council-initiated referendum questions regarding increasing or creating ancillary fees, including:

- Notice of Motion Regarding Student Services Ancillary Fee Referendum Question
- Notice of Motion Regarding Athletics Ancillary Fee Referendum Question
- Notice of Motion Regarding Creation of a McGill Writing Centre Ancillary Fee Referendum Question

Resolved, that the SSMU Legislative Council deem the Winter 2013 referendum period an exceptional referendum period with no change to the current electoral timeline of Elections SSMU.
