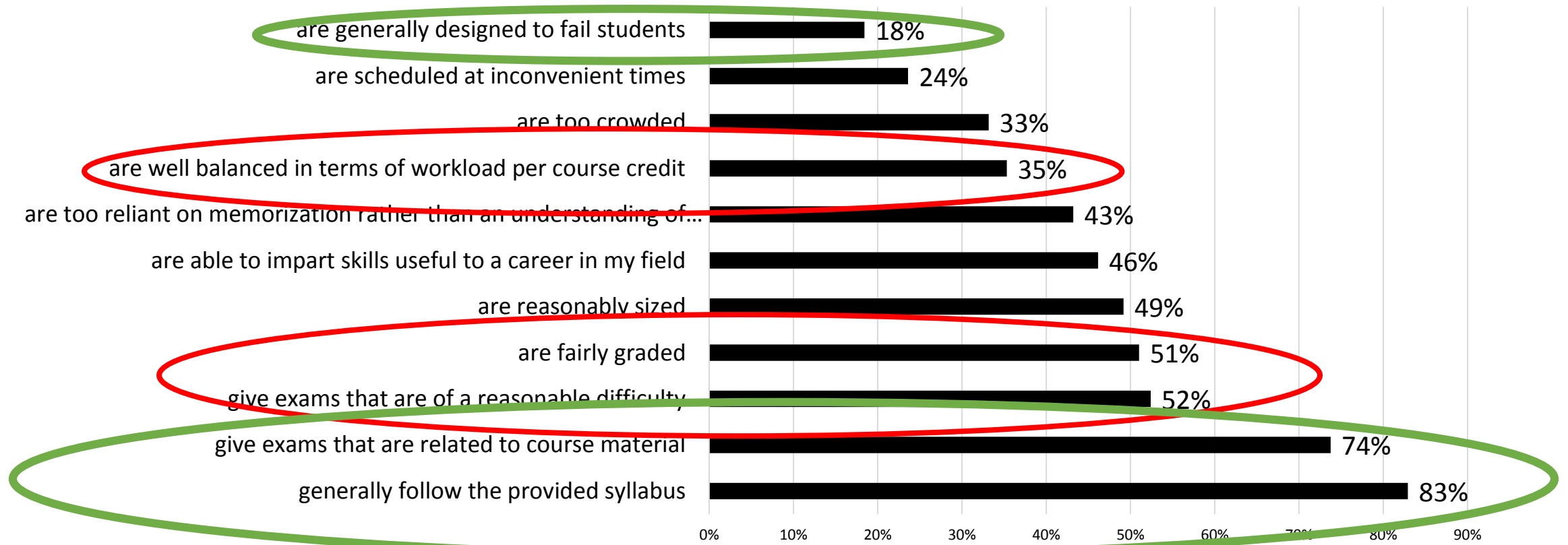

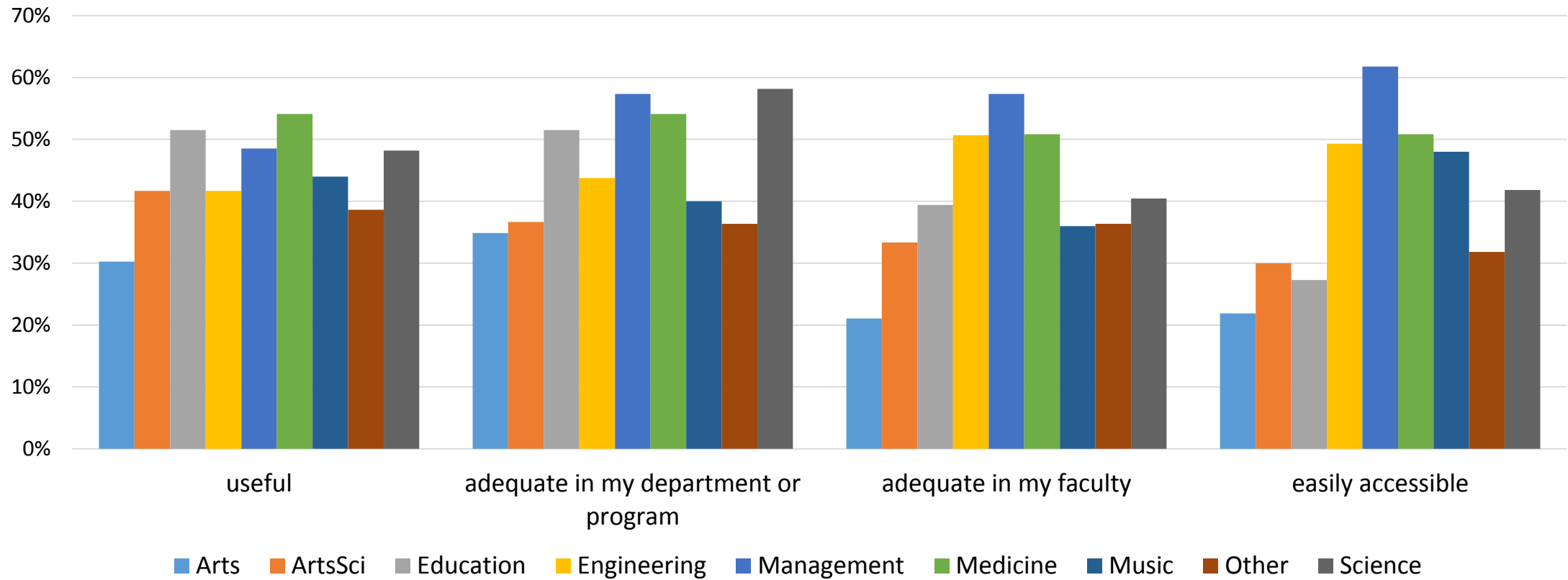
"My courses _____" Percentage of respondents who agree or strongly agree

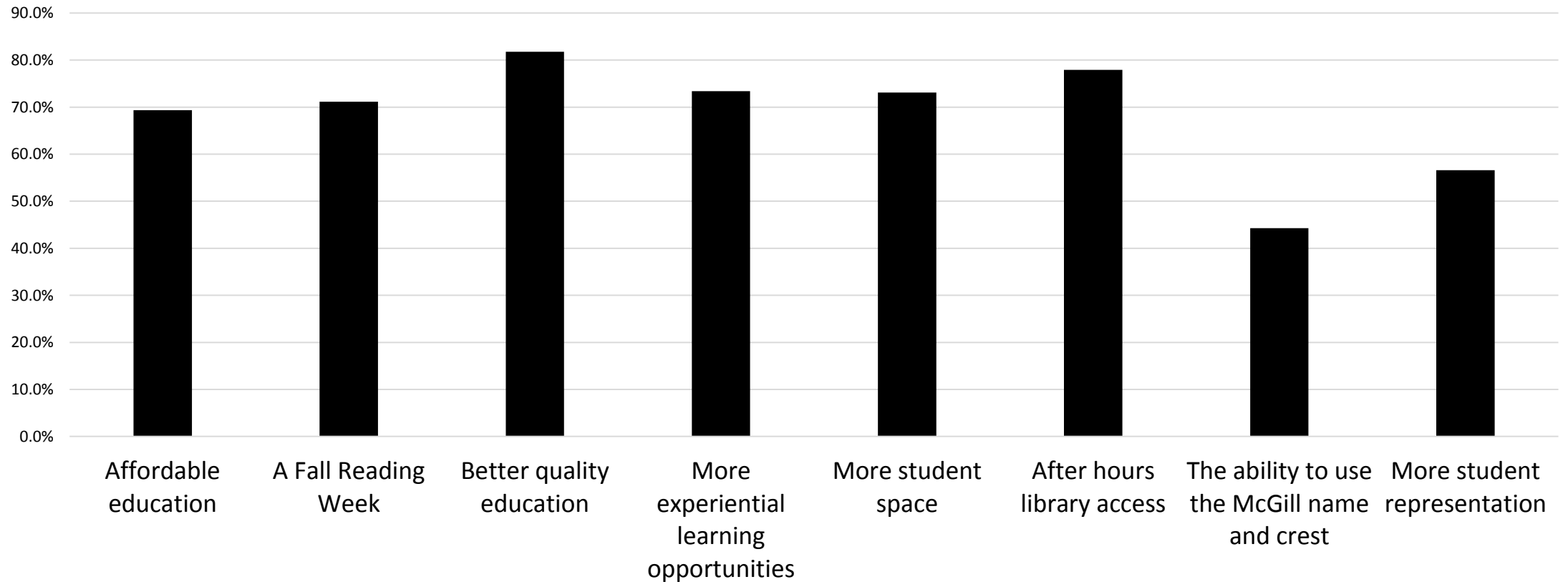
