Article I - Name

McGill Students' Santropol Roulant

Article II - Objectives

- a) To deliver meals to citizens experiencing a temporary or permanent loss of autonomy.
- b) To improve the overall quality of life of people in need of home care services.
- c) To cultivate and promote the benefits of inter-generation community service.

Article III - Membership

Full Members will include SSMU students as voting members. Participation from non-students is welcome and will be considered Associate non-voting members.

Article IV - Executive

The executive shall consist of a Chairperson, two Vice-Presidents and a Secretary.

Article V - Executive Duties

The Chairperson shall:

- organize inauguration task forces;
- set up election infrastructure;
- act as a spokesperson
- chair meetings;
- co-sign financial documents with one the designated V.P;
- co-sign minutes with Secretary.

The Vice-Presidents shall:

as designated, establish a membership campaign within the university;
as designated, be responsible for the finances of the club and co-sign financial documents with the Chairperson;
as directed, be responsible for the directing of group activities or objectives;
as designated, assume chairperson responsibilities in his/her absence.

The Secretary shall:

be custodian of all club documents;
keep minutes held and ensure distribution;
co-sign all the minutes with Chairperson.

Article VI - Fees and Finances

Membership fees will stand at \$5.00. Any change to the fee shall be approved by the members. A general meeting shall be held on a biweekly basis. A general meeting shall be held at least once per term. Members shall be notified one week in advance by means of the SSMU notice boards and the McGill Tribune/Daily. Quorum for General Meetings shall be 50% + 1 of the members.

Article VII - Elections

Election of officers shall take place in January at the general meeting, by mean of closed ballot.

Article VIII - Amendments

Amendments to this constitution require (2/3) of the voting members approval and with approval of the SSMU Council.

Article IX - Affiliation

McGill Students' Meals on Wheels will actively seek affiliation with the outside organizations if deemed beneficial to club objectives.

Article X - SSMU Constitution

All constitutional rights and responsibilities of the organization not stated are subject to the SSMU Constitution.
