


# REPORT OF THE VICE-PRESIDENT (UNIVERSITY AFFAIRS)

### McGill Policy against Sexual Violence

- Attended roundtable meetings with Parker P Consulting & Partners Meeting for <u>major SSHRC</u> research project addressing sexual violence on university campuses (November 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>)
- Met with Associate Provost to discuss final policy revisions on Monday, November 14<sup>th</sup>
- Policy will be presented to Senate for approval on Wednesday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>; now looking towards implementation plans & proposal for comprehensive review of existing policies

#### McGill Ad-Hoc Committee to Review the Charter of Student Rights

- SQ Priorities include stronger language on accommodations, disability & intersectionality; ensuring consistency with other policies; improving students' awareness of their rights
- Next meeting on Tuesday, November 29<sup>th</sup> to continue discussing revisions

### **Unpaid Internships Policy**

- Awaiting response from Provost to Senate question regarding McGill regulation of unpaid internship postings (next Wednesday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>)
- Delayed in drafting process due to loss of student researcher; currently recruiting councillors to assist with policy-writing (aiming to have approved by end of January)

- Developing promotional materials, volunteer recruitment, & Faculty association collaborations for January outreach campaign (including possible panel event on academic rights)
- Collaborating with Faculty associations on assessment policy inventory (summarizing existing procedures, identifying gaps, sharing policy examples, & training on advocacy strategies)
