POLICY DEVELOPMENT

McGill Policy Against Sexual Violence

- Draft <u>Policy Against Sexual Violence</u> to be presented at October 19th Senate meeting alongside report on community consultations, initial proposed revisions
- Released consultation report with 24 recommendations in six categories: Language & Framing, Scope, Empowering Survivors, Education & Awareness, Support Resources, Accountability
- Meeting with Associate Provost this Friday, October 14th regarding recommendations

McGill Ad-Hoc Committee to Review the Charter of Student Rights

- SQ Priorities include stronger language on accommodations, disability & intersectionality; ensuring consistency with other policies; improving students' awareness of their rights
- Next meeting on Thursday, October 27th to begin revising text

Unpaid Internships Policy

- Met with Career Planning Service (CaPS) on Wednesday, October 5th; meeting with Arts Internship Office (AIO) next Tuesday, October 18th; may meet with other Faculty offices as-needed
- Submitted question regarding regulation of unpaid internships for October 20th Senate meeting
- Presentation on background research at next Legislative Council (Thursday, October 20th), followed by draft policy framework for student consultation

McGill Smoking Policy

- McGill working group drafting policy for transition to a smoke-free campus, based on consultation results & requirements outlined in SSMU <u>Smoking on Campus Policy</u>
- Town Hall scheduled for Tuesday, October 25th from 2:30-4:30PM, Redpath Museum Auditorium
