Motion Regarding Amendments to the Constitution for GA Quorum 2018-11-01

WHEREAS, the primary function of the General Assembly is to “receive and take note of the annual report of the Board of Directors [and] the financial statements of the society;¹”

WHEREAS, the current quorum does not encourage the general membership to participate at the GA due to the belief that quorum will not be reached.

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the constitution be amended so as to change quorum for General Assemblies, as follows:

13.4 QUORUM. Unless the Act of the Letters Patent of the Society dictate otherwise, quorum for a regular General Assembly shall be ~~one hundred and fifty (150) three hundred and fifty (350)~~ **one hundred and fifty (150)** Members.

The Speaker shall not count towards the quorum at the General Assembly.
