What is the Board of Directors?

Composition

- 4 SSMU executives
- 4 Members at Large
- 4 SSMU Councillors
- 1 International Student Representative (non-voting)

Board of Directors: Powers

- Highest governing body for the Society
- Is responsible for the following aspects of the Society:
 - Financial
 - Legal
 - Operational
- Meets bi-weekly
- Decisional around SSMU's MOA and Building Lease with McGill

Decisions Made at the Board Level

Financing

- Legal fees for Involvement Restriction policy
- Approval of architectural plans for 3501 Peel
- Approval of pizza oven for Gerts use once reopened

Decisional

- Taking on financial risk for clubs so Clubs can have credit cards
- Approval of architectural plans for 3501 Peel
- Approval of use of 680 Sherbrooke for student groups, saving \$80k for the first 3 months, additional \$150k every year after

- Relationship to Legislative Council
- Full committee report to come with recommendations to come at the end of March
