Background and Rationale

Risk Factors and Resource Implications

Because this motion requires a proposal to be presented in the next Council year, there is a chance that details of the proposal are miscommunicated due to Executive turnover. Therefore, it is important that this plan is properly transitioned.

In addition, History SSMU would require its own presumably part-time staff, meaning that the President will have to include in the proposal how the department will be funded.

Sustainability Considerations

The President should ensure that any proposal for the creation of *History SSMU* has sustainability considerations and does not misappropriate unnecessary resources.

Impact of Decision and Next Steps

Following the passage of this motion, the President should devise the *Proposal for the Development of History SSMU*. Because this is the last meeting of the 2019-2020 Council, this plan will be introduced to the 2020-2021 Legislative Council.

Motion or Resolution for Approval

Be it resolved that the President of the create the Proposal for the Development of History SSMU, which shall be presented to the next Legislative Council meeting by the President of the 2020-2021 Academic Year. If the Proposal is not completed before the Executive Turnover, the President of the 2020-2021 shall finish it.

Be it further resolved that the Legislative Council assert that the potential *History SSMU* be an impartial body within the Society that documents current activities of the Society, researches the history of the Society, and assists Society officials and student members who wish to learn more about SSMU.

Be it further resolved that the *Proposal for the Development of History SSMU* also include other ways to document the history of the Society without creating a seperate body.
