Alignment with Mission	As per article 20 of the SSMU Constitution: "Unless otherwise provided for by law, the Constitution may be amended, superseded, or repealed by way of a Referendum."
Overview of Proposed Amendments	As per the recommendation from the judicial board, we have been advised to adopt the 2020 Constitution in both English and French. Key Changes from the 2017 version include
	Greater Commitment to Representation in the Preamble A Renewed Vision for the Justice Board Authority of the French Constitution Representation for the School of Religious Studies (Bachelors of Theology) to Legislative Council Formatting of Resolutions
Consultations Completed	Consulted with the SSMU President, Chief Electoral Officer, Deputy Electoral Officer & Governance Manager.
Risk Factors and Resource Implications	Elections SSMU will need time to organize, and publicize this event. SSMU would need to dedicate resources for campaigning. Due to the remote semester, it may be harder to meet quorum for the motion to pass.
Sustainability Considerations	A considerable sustainability point is the longevity and wellbeing of the Society. In order to properly function, it is crucial to adopt a Constitution that corresponds to the Society's Membership representation and advocacy, as well as be in accordance with Quebec legislation.
Impact of Decision and Next Steps	Should this decision pass, the SSMU will operate under the guise of the 2020 Constitution. As a result, key changes as outlined in the "Overview of Proposed Amendments" will be implemented. Should this decision fail, the SSMU will revert back to the last Constitution that was properly adopted in 2017.
