

Issue	This motion seeks to an order to clarify inconsis reports to Council.			•	of the Legislative Council in bmission of Executive	
Background and Rationale		The Standing Rules for the 2020-2021 Legislative Council include an inconsistency regarding the submission of Executive reports to Council. Section 3.1. suggests that Executive reports to Council are due on the Monday night before Council, when in fact they are understood to be due on the Tuesday night before Council.				
		Further, section 3.4. indicates that all reports, except the Club Committee and the Funding Committee, are due at midnight on the Sunday before the Council session. This is inconsistent with the existing section 3.1. of the Standing Rules, and the actual facts concerning the submission of Executive reports.				
•		This motion clarifies both of these inconsistencies by amending both sections 3.1. and 3.4.

Appendix A : Proposed Amendments to the Standing Rules of Legislative Council

3. Reports

- 3.1. All Executives must submit a report detailing their activities related to the Society since the last Monday in which the previous report was submitted scheduled submission deadline of a report to Council. Executive reports must be submitted no later than 11:59 PM ET on the Tuesday immediately preceding Council.
- 3.4. All reports must be submitted no later than 11:59 PM ET five (5) days immediately preceding Council generally on Sunday, with the exception of the Funding Committee and Club Committee, the Club Committee, and the Executives.
