 - Revised Budgets are being submitted over the next two week for our review and approval

Budget

- Budget Revision delayed to November
 - Due to a desire to consult the Finance committee, need for budget estimations from management, and need to account for recent operational expenses and difficulties we have encountered.
- In the meantime, had a meeting with every department head to go over current budgets, expenses that were needed outside of it, and wish lists for the budget surplus
- We will be doing an accrual of the Winter fees to get a fuller picture of what we have to work for, but as mentioned before we estimate around 300k more than expected.



McGill Engineering Competition


Description of Application and Basis for Approval Amount

MSS Kits for Kids


Description of Application and Basis for Approval Amount


Description of Application and Basis for Approval Amount




