Accounting

- Hired an administrative assistant for Gert's to help manage inventory and logistics
 - Looking to finish fixing inventory shortfalls and move forward to make Gerts as efficient as ever!
- The Audit has been officially completed! Thanks to the accounting team for the positive outcome.

Clubs and Services

- Club credit cards still delayed
 - Should arrive over the next couple weeks, RBC took a long time to send us the card contracts
 - These have been filled out and RBC is slowly shipping them over
- Club banking Access should be done or close to done for the second wave of banking Services Contract
 - This includes all applications up to November 4th
- Finally received new accounts from RBC after going after them for 2 months
 - CFC working on giving access to the relevant clubs.
- Continued to help Clubs/Services with their expenses
- Revised Budgets for Services have mostly been submitted
 - Slowly going over them with the Service Finance Coordinator to make sure all expenses are legitimate

Budget

- Budget Revision
 - Finance Committee was part of preliminary consultations, was unable to have a second meeting on it but used their input when devising the new budget
 - The Budget was presented at this LegCo meeting!
 - Took a lot of work, especially with getting the handle of how pivot tables work.



- Accrual of the Winter fees was completed to get a fuller picture of what we have to work for, but as mentioned before we estimate around 300k more than expected.
 - However, budget mistakes from last year made a serious dent in our projections.
 - Our surplus from last year makes a useful buffer to counter these issues.

Funding

• Funding committee meetings keep going strong! Approved applications are listed below.

Investments

- Worked with RBC to get much better GICs (0.95%!), moving the OADF into long-term investments, awaiting Board approval
 - This latter change will hopefully at least double the amount of Awards of Distinctions at the end of the year.

Referenda

- Referendum was a success!
 - Some small issues re: the budget, but the second referendum ran smoothly
 - Participation and engagement is up!

Projects

- Looking to improve our budget/reporting systems
 - Massive discrepancies between actuals and last year's budget in a variety of fields,
 both positive and negative, makes projections much harder to make.
 - Hoping to get the changes on line by the beginning of January so the next Budget is done with more accuracy and clarity
- Planning on a membership fee increase for the winter semester
 - Major issue is the significant increases in expenses due to inflation and possible salary increases
 - Will make an in-depth budget to guarantee that students are making an informed decision
 - Will be looping this into the 5-year-plan to ensure that our operational needs are benign taken care of.
