What is the Board of Directors?

Composition + Requirements + Powers

Composition

- Four (4) Executives
- Four (4) Councillors
- Four (4) Members-at-Large
 - Applications are open for members-at-large on the Board of Directors

The General Manager is an *ex-officio* and non-voting member.

Requirements

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Citizen or permanent resident of Canada
- Not be bankrupt
- Not have been declared incapable by a court
- Not have a criminal record

Powers

- Highest governing body of the SSMU
- Responsible for the SSMU's:
 - o Finances
 - o Operations
 - Human Resources
 - o Legal
- Ratifies the resolutions passed by the Legislative Council

The Board of Directors meets bi-weekly during the academic year.
