REPORT OF THE VICE-PRESIDENT (FINANCE) Marco Pizarro



Accounting

- Without the absence of the General Manager, I met with 5 out of the 6 personne in the accounting team to understand the complexity of the department and worked to make it more accessible to students.

- Then we prepared for the audit. Thanks to the great work of last year, the audit went well
 according to Desmond, the Comptroller. It was not easy as a lot happened this year which
