## Report of the Management Representative Inayat Seth to the Legislative Council

### MUS Council

- Constitutional amendments
  - Official change of VP Development and Outreach to VP SEDI (Sustainability, Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion)
  - Official recognition of an associate VP Events (Better organization and monitoring of events, as seen with Frosh and 4a7)
  - Better definition of VPs' due diligence to ensure appropriate and timely removal if needed
    - Poor meeting attendance and failure to report state of portfolio
    - Lack of engagement or poor responsiveness to the student body
  - In general, the review aims to update the Constitution to account for changes since 2017
- Finances
  - Master Budget is coming up and seems to be in order
    - VP Finance proposing a change in policies to MUS Board to have all expenses approved by Finance and all Finance expenses approved by the MUS president (to ensure no third party approved expenses)
- HR and Ombudsperson
  - Ombudsperson will be working with HR committee and Ethics Board to redefine HR procedures in order to avoid bias/discrimination and implement more effective control processes
  - Planning to contact other members of the Canadian Association of Business Students (CABS) to learn from their HR processes

### Events/Activities

- Involvement Package
  - Record involvement – 438 applicants this semester, impressive considering there are approximately 600 involvement opportunities
    - JED Consulting reached record applicants + funding
    - Case League also reached a record of applicants, demonstrating an increase in involvement related to competitions
- Clubs and Activities Night
  - Was a success and had a great turnout!
- Academics
  - Very few complaints from students according to VP Academic

  - Was an absolute success
