### **Open Letter on McGill's platforming of TERFs**

Like it or not: McGill University is actively contributing to the genocide of trans people across the world.

McGill's Faculty of Law, by actively giving a platform to the anti-trans lawyer Robert Wintemute, is directly contributing to the same rollback of human rights that has been plaguing our world as of late. The sheer irony in platforming him through the Centre for Human Rights and Legal Pluralism cannot be understated: trans rights cannot be separated from gay or lesbian rights and are not at odds with the rights of children, nor of cis women. Undermining the human rights of trans people does not benefit any member of the 2SLGBTQIA+ community, nor the feminist movement.

Robert Wintemute is a member of the LGB Alliance, an anti-trans lobbying group which has become increasingly influential in the UK over the past few years. You may have heard of the LGB Alliance from the time [their founder, Allison Bailey, sued Stonewall](#) (and lost). If that tidbit of information doesn't make it clear where the so-called Alliance stands in regards to

2SLGBTQIA+ rights, you may be interested in learning that [only 7% of their supporters are actually lesbians](#), a strikingly low number given that the group often claims to be working on behalf of lesbian rights. In fact, it's quite easy to realize that the LGB Alliance does not represent nor support gay and lesbian people, as it has stated publicly that [it's not homophobic to oppose same-sex marriage](#). The Alliance is also a [big fan of conversion therapy](#). So much for protecting lesbians and gays!

If you're wondering where the LGB Alliance got the idea that "the LGB must divorce from the T" (as Robert Wintemute intends to argue this Tuesday on McGill campus), wonder no more: ["Drop the T" is a Christian right-supported campaign to "divide and conquer" the LGBT community](#)". At this point, you might be thinking: hey, aren't they just another far-right hate group? Well, you wouldn't be wrong, as this is also the opinion of [the Global Project Against Hate and Extremism \(GPAHE\)](#). And if you need more convincing, the fact that [co-founder Bev Jackson loves hanging out with the Heritage Foundation](#), and that their [former social media manager Gary Powell now works with said Heritage Foundation](#), might clue you in. If you're not familiar with them, the Heritage Foundation is one of the most influential conservative think tanks in the world. They're vocal climate change deniers, they're anti-abortion (anti-women, really), they lobby continuously to ban critical race theory, and they've gone on record saying that opposing white supremacy is equivalent to opposing American culture. This is the kind of people the LGB Alliance willingly associates with, while their founder is busy suing Stonewall, a legitimate LGBTQ+ organization. [Gary Powell also has ties to other far-right groups](#) such as the Center for Bioethics and Culture Network, the Alliance Defending Freedom, and Public Discourse. What's more? The LGB Alliance literally [shares a building with dozens of other far-right think tanks and groups](#). There is no shadow of a doubt that the LGB Alliance is a hate group weaponizing feminist and gay buzzwords to hide behind a thin veneer of "progressivism".

As much as McGill may try to absolve itself from blame by claiming its right to academic liberty, we must refute that argument by stating that the tolerance of intolerance ultimately results in the wiping out of tolerance.<sup>1</sup> Would McGill give a platform to an openly misogynistic lawyer advocating actively for sending women back into the kitchen, under the guise of debate? No. Then why would McGill do the same, albeit to trans people? Undermining trans rights is a gateway towards enabling further attacks on people's bodily autonomy – especially for racialized cis women and intersex people, who do not fit the narrow mold of "womanhood" that the so-called "gender critical" movement dictates. In fact, thousands of cis women are currently accepting signatures on their [open letter in protest of the LGB Alliance](#) and other anti-trans groups in the UK.

McGill may try to appear as a diverse and inclusive place, but ultimately, we know that it is a sham. The university still does not recognize non-binary people, more than six months after the Quebec government recognized them and close to four years since the federal government did so. Numerous trans patients have noted their struggles, at MUSIC (McGill U. Sexual Identity Centre) as well as beyond. We also can't help but also note that this event inscribes itself in a continuum of the maintenance of colonial structures of oppression, in which McGill has participated for the entirety of its 200-plus-year history.

As anti-trans violence becomes increasingly prevalent across the world, and legal gender recognition is threatened in the UK, in the US, and [here in Quebec itself](#), every extra minute of airtime given to an anti-trans activist may result in further rollback. Every such minute will contribute to the premature deaths of trans people worldwide. It's about time that we all say "no" to this continued, systemic elimination of trans voices and lives – and that time is now.

We, the undersigned, demand that McGill's Centre for Human Rights and Legal Pluralism, Faculty of Law, and its decision-makers hold themselves accountable for the harm they are causing to trans people, and demand that no such event shall ever happen again on campus.
