Alignment with Mission	As this project provides a unique experience for students and aligns with MASS' mandate, it aligns with the Society's mission to provide social and personal opportunities to McGill students.
Consultations Completed	The application has been approved by the funding committee.
Risk Factors and Resource Implications	The amount being asked, 18139.66, is a significant amount of money, and many smaller initiatives could be funded using this sum. However, based on previous years' funding disbursements and current projections, it is unlikely that the Club Fund will be depleted. Additionally, there is a surplus of fund from previous years (as described above). Thus, this motion poses very little risk to future funding applications.
Sustainability Considerations	This motion doesn't have a significant impact on sustainability. Sustainability has not been taken into account significantly by the event hosts.
Impact of Decision and Next Steps	If approved, the funding application will be approved and the funding amount will be disbursed to the group. The Funding Commissioner will process the application and inform MASS.
Motion or Resolution for Approval	Be it resolved that the Legislative Council approves the Club Fund application #6428 submitted by MASS for 18139.66.


