The VP Finance, VP Student Life, and services coordinator have all been consulted.

Risk Factors and Resource Implications

If this motion passes, the question of the Plate Club renewal will be presented in the Winter 2023 Referendum. The fee is only \$0.14 cents, so the risk is limited in terms of financial loss for students. However, a loss of this service on campus will result in a loss in sustainability across all campus events. McGill University is one of the few university campuses with a service similar to this, and it demonstrates that sustainability is an important value to SSMU.

Sustainability Considerations

This motion significantly impacts SSMU's sustainability efforts. Its efforts will be significantly undermined if the Plate Club fee is not renewed, or not sent to referendum for renewal, as it represents a sustainable option for students that would otherwise need to use disposable options for their events. If students don't have this option, it will be harder for them to have events that meet SSMU's sustainability requirements.

Impact of Decision and Next Steps

If the motion is approved, the question will be sent to referendum and the students will vote on it.

Motion or Resolution for Approval

Be it resolved that the Legislative Council approve the following question for the Winter 2023 referendum period:

Do you agree to the renewal of the opt-outable Plate Club Fee of \$0.14, to be charged per semester to all undergraduate students who are members of the SSMU in Winter 2023 and ending in Winter 2027 (inclusive), with the understanding that a "no" vote will result in the discontinuation of the fee?

Be it further resolved, a budget be provided on the final ballot
