The sustainability commissioners deliberate on all applications that the funding committee receives towards the environment fund.

Alignment with Mission

Impact of Decision and Next Steps

If this motion is passed, the environment fee renewal will be added to the Winter 2023 Referendum. If the referendum passes, the Environment Fee will continue to exist as an opt-outable fee for students.

Motion or Resolution for Approval

Be it resolved, that the Legislative Council approve the following question for the Winter 2023 Referendum period:

"Do you agree to the renewal of the opt-outable Environment fee of \$1.00 per semester, per student, payable by all undergraduate students who are members of the SSMU, starting Fall 2023 and ending in Winter 2028 (inclusive), excluding summers, with the understanding that a majority vote "no" would lead to a reduction in the amount of money available to students who wish to start sustainable initiatives?"

Be it further resolved, that a budget will be provided on referendum ballot outlining the allocation of this fee in the spirit of financial transparency.

Be it further resolved, that the SSMU Legislative Council adopts the actionable aspects of this question and that any grammatical or technical changes necessary do not need the re-approval of the Legislative Council.

Be it further resolved, that the Legislative Council approves this motion, and recommends the ratification to the Board of Directors.
