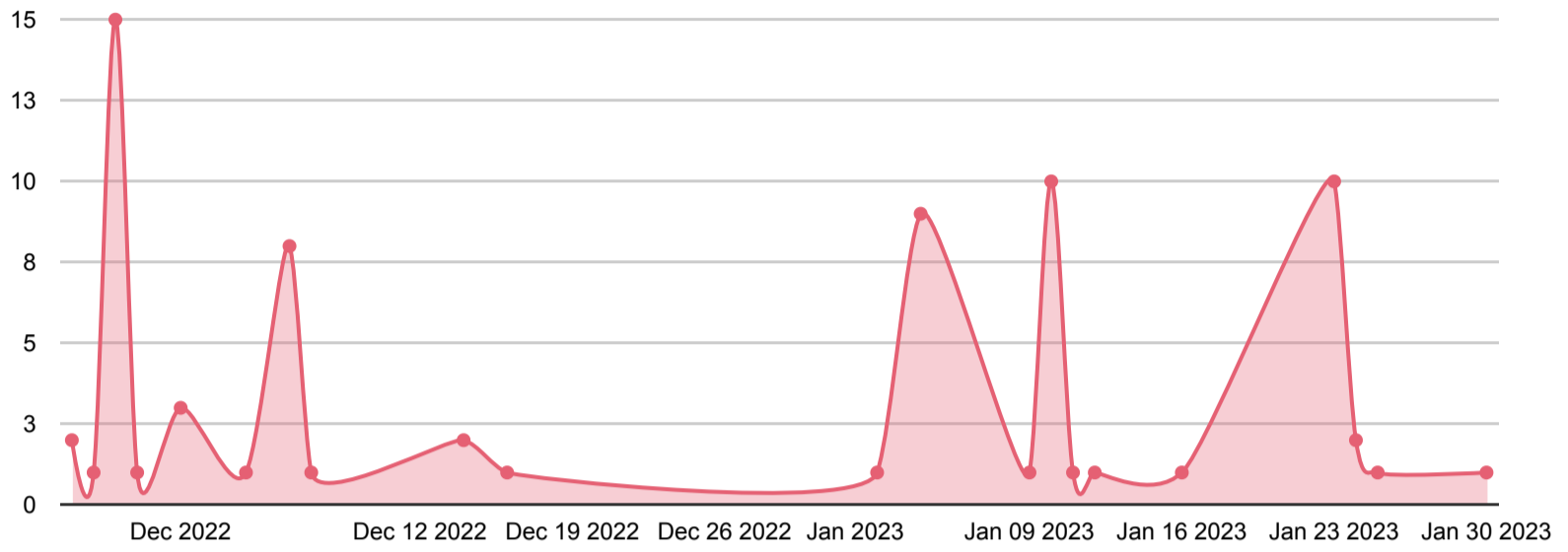

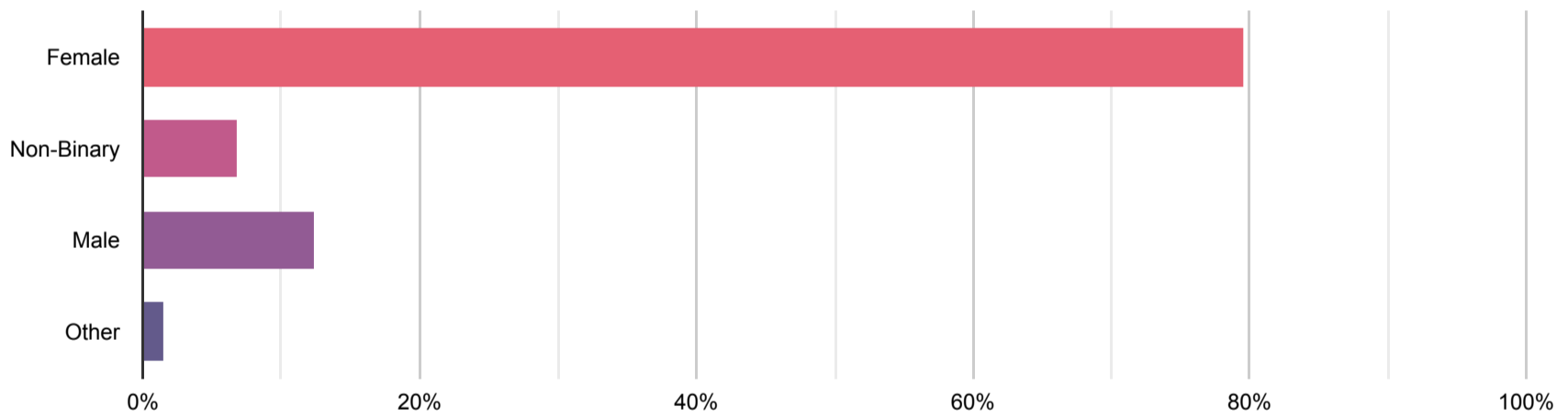

1. How do you identify?

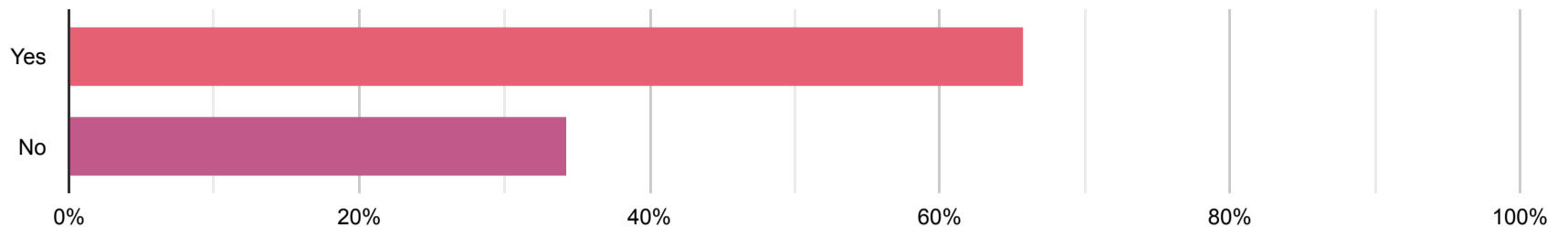

2. Have you ever witnessed/heard of any sexual harassment incident on campus?

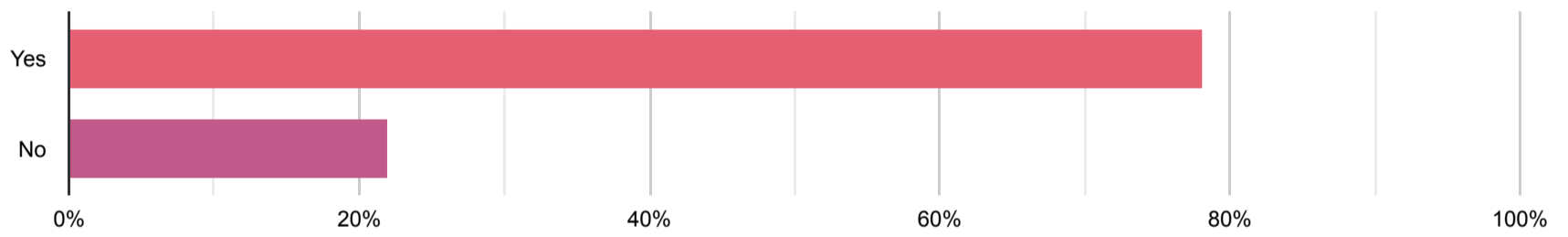

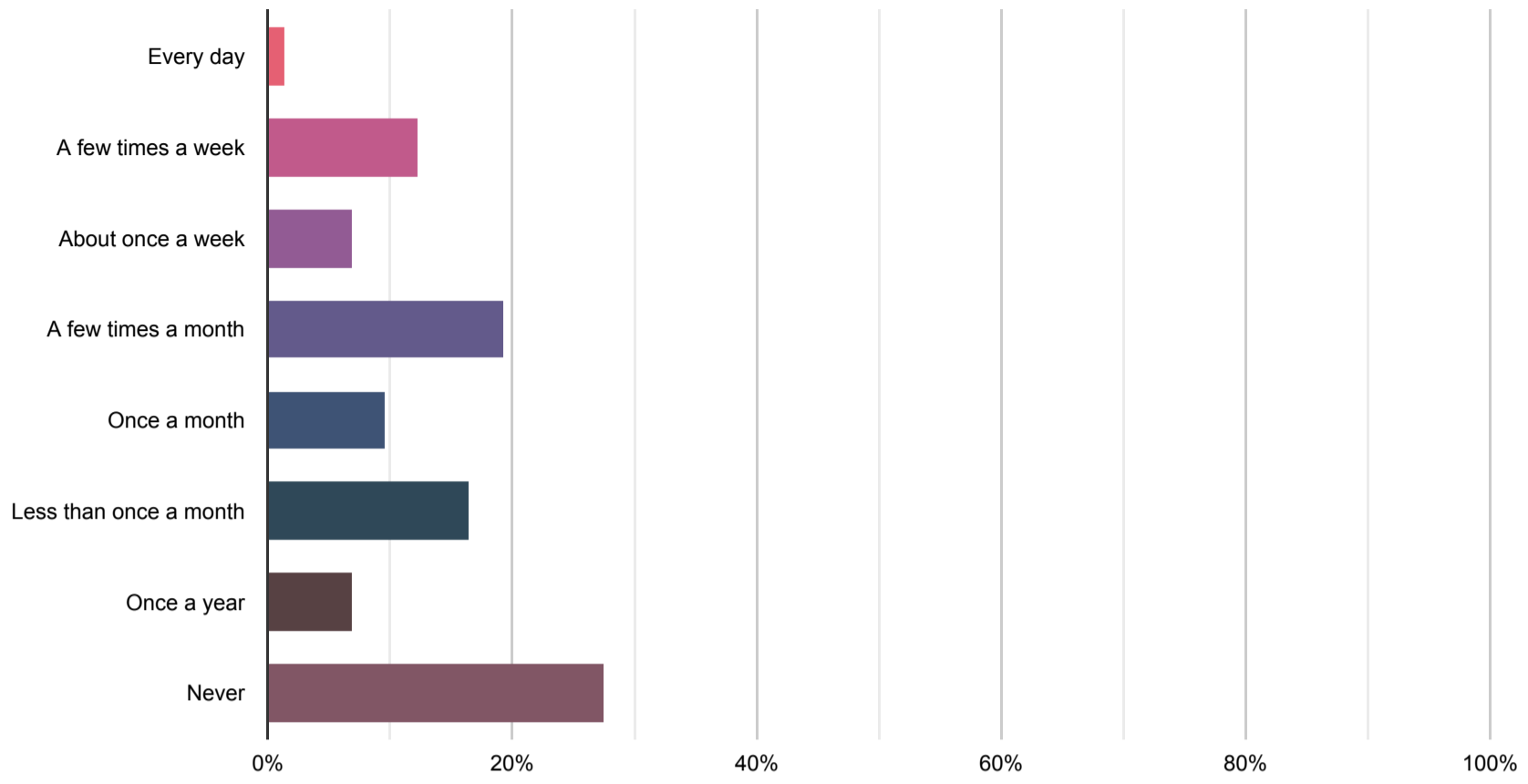

4. How often do you feel unsafe on/near campus, due to fear of being sexually harassed?

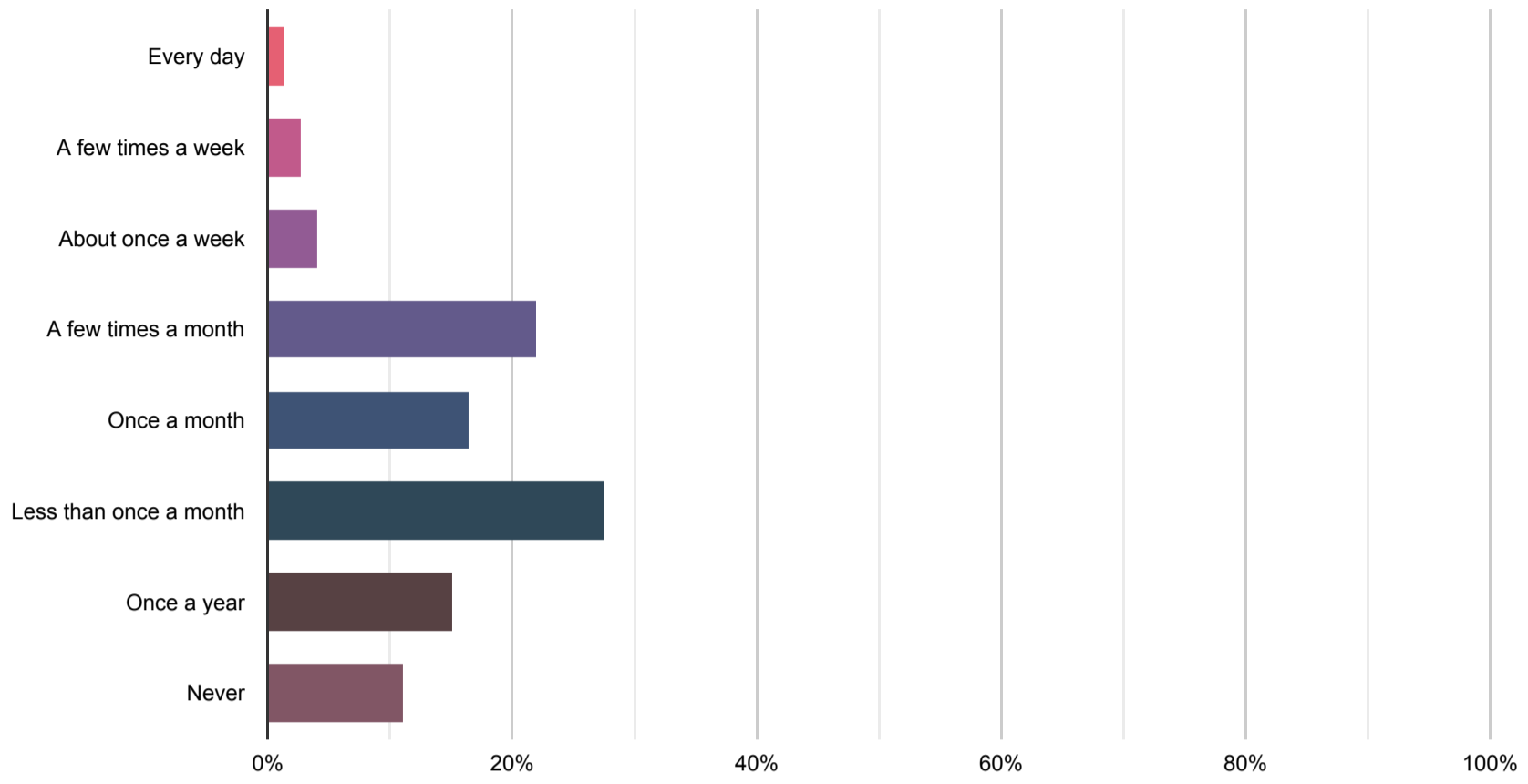

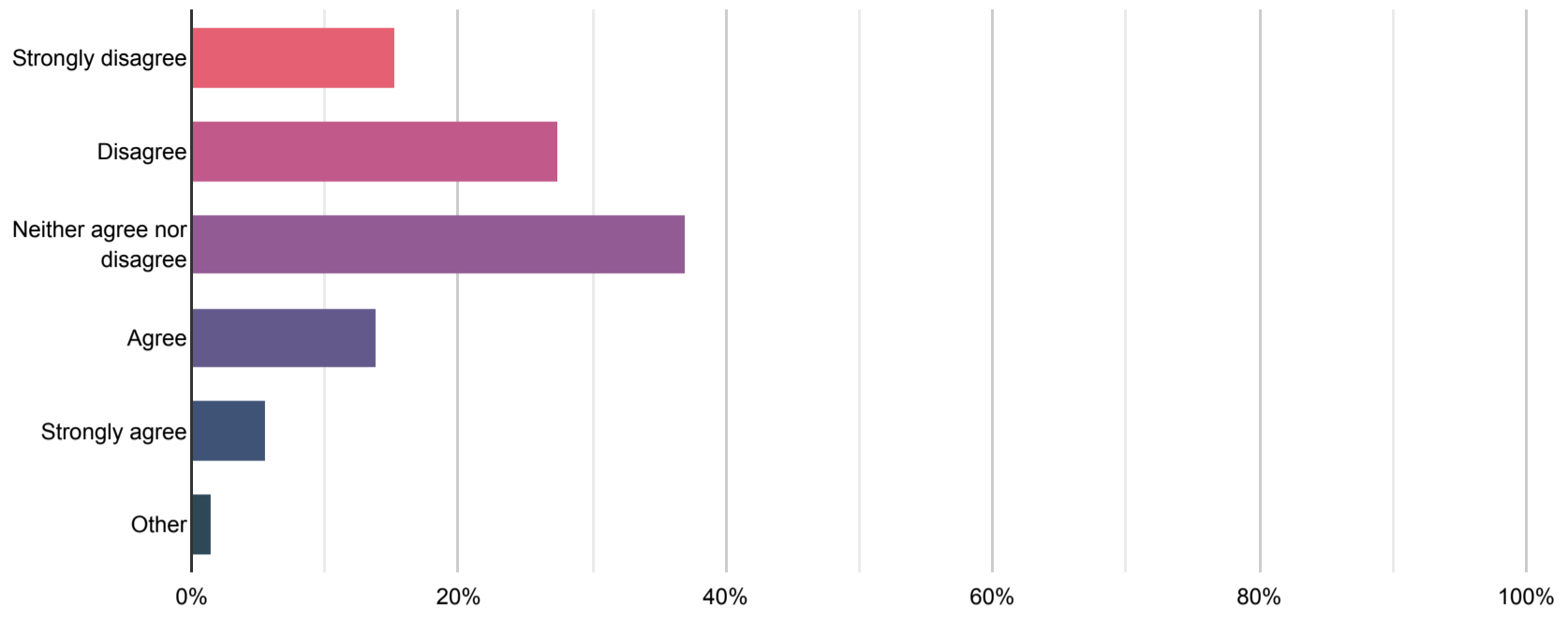

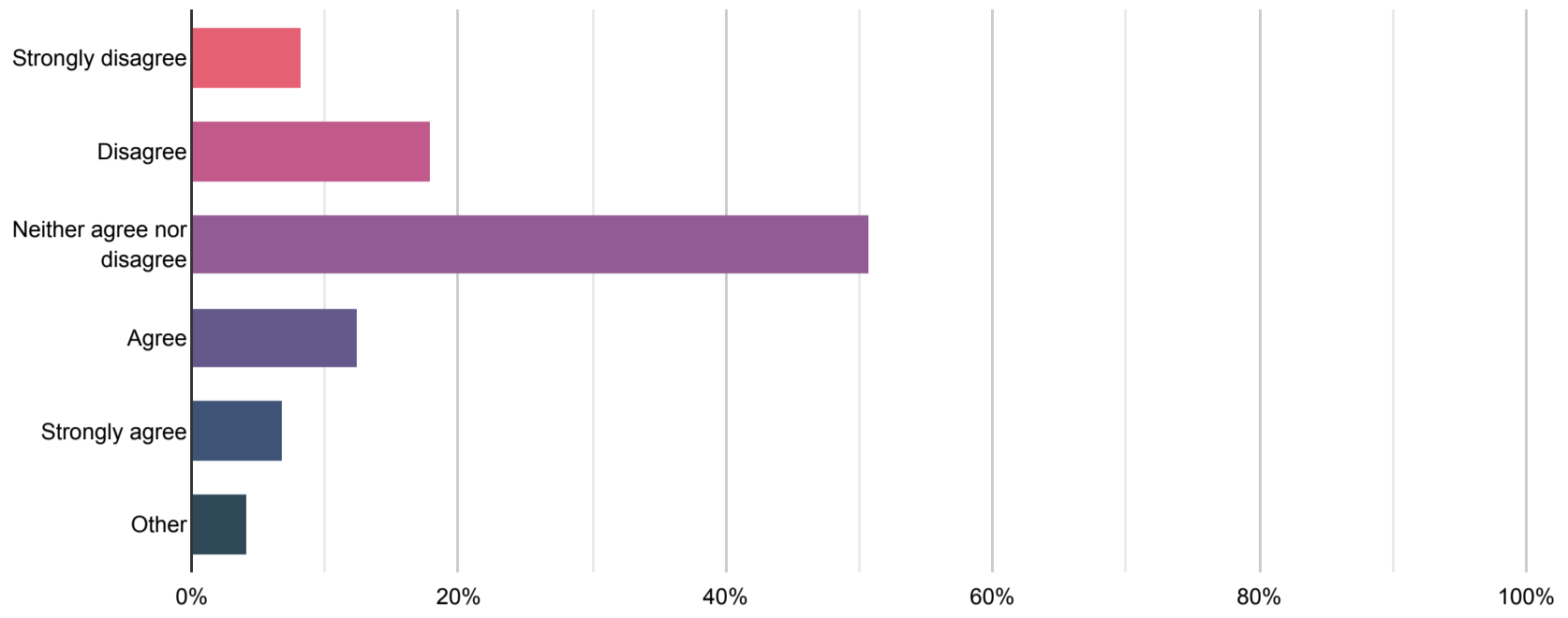

7. Do you think SSMU is doing an adequate job preventing possible sexual harassment incidents?

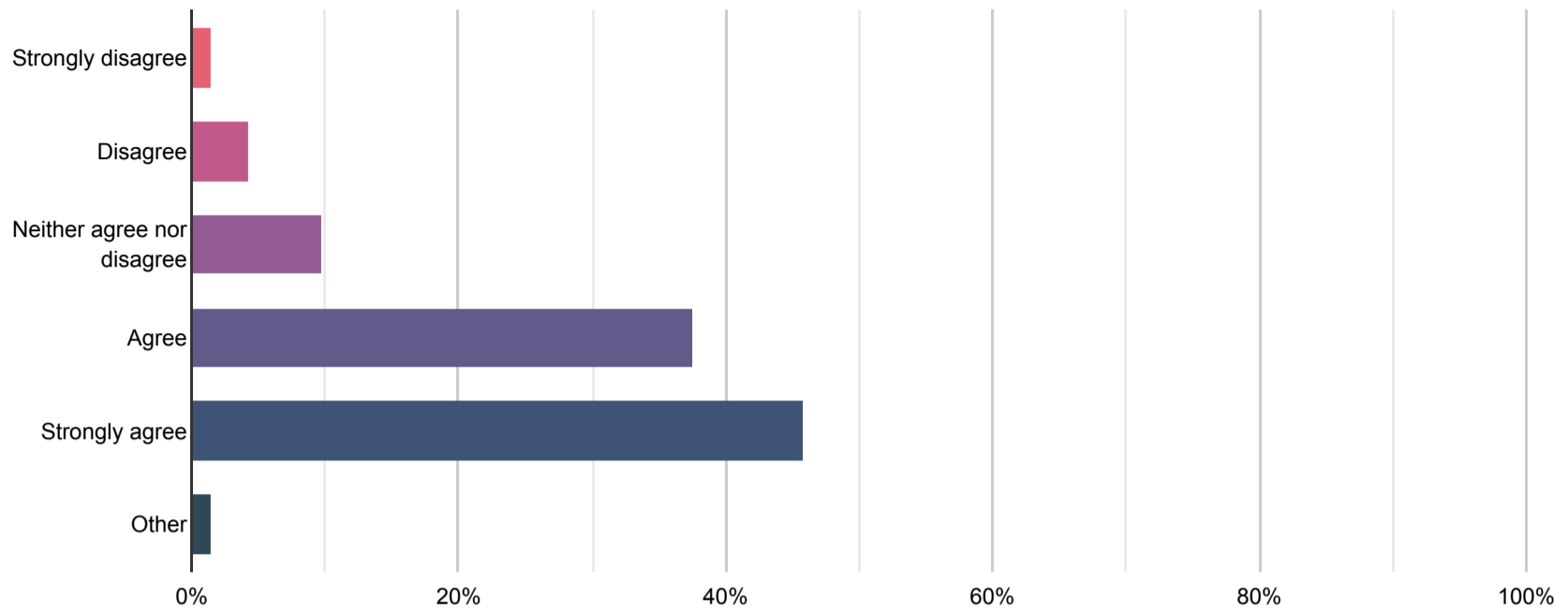

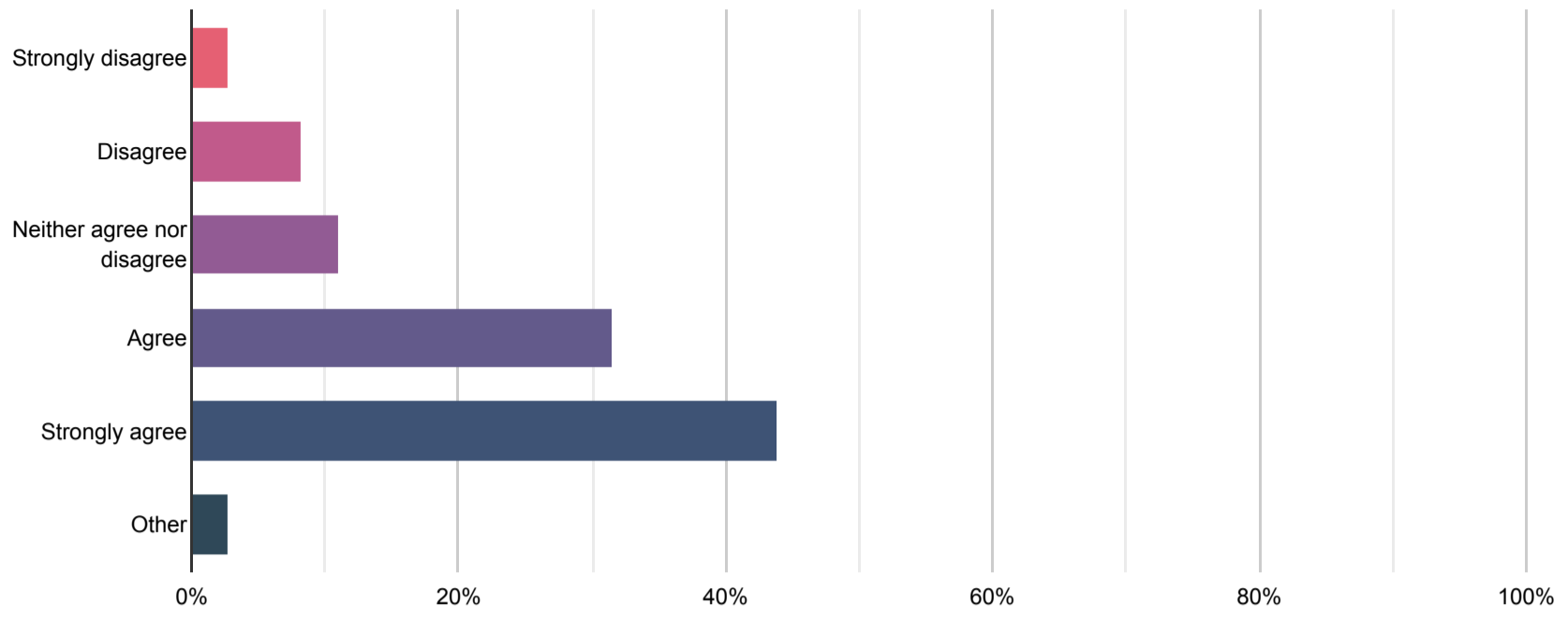

9. HAVEN costs 7 cents per student per month. Do you think the benefits offered by the app is reasonable given its price?

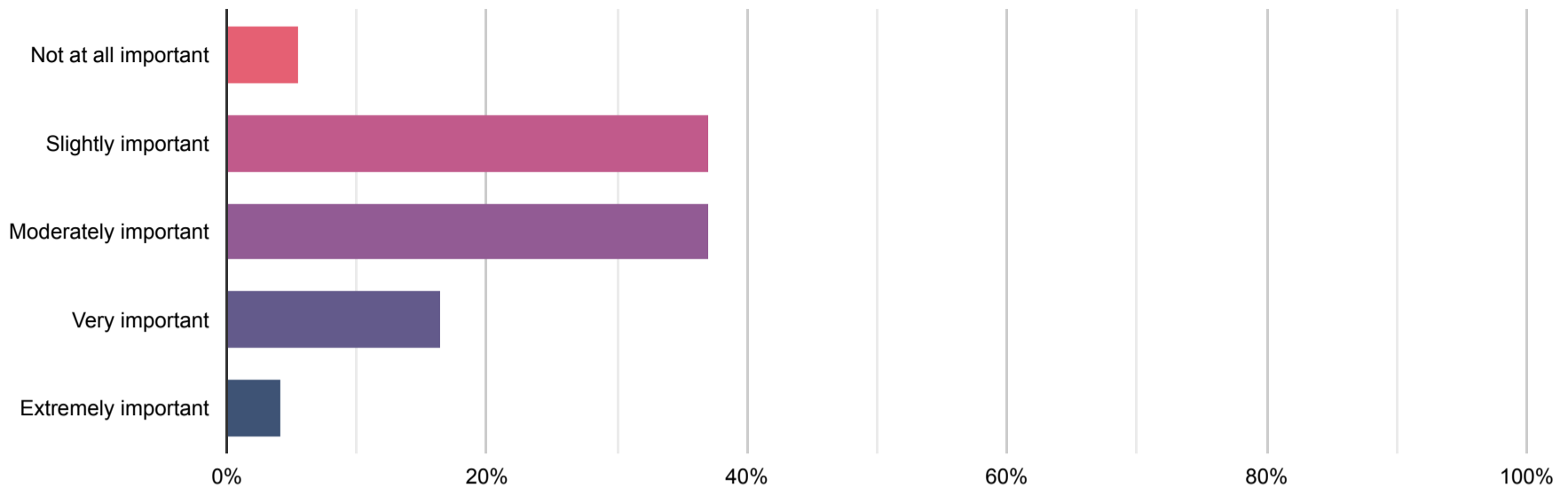

10. How important of a role do you believe this app would play in preventing and/or reducing instances of sexual harassment?

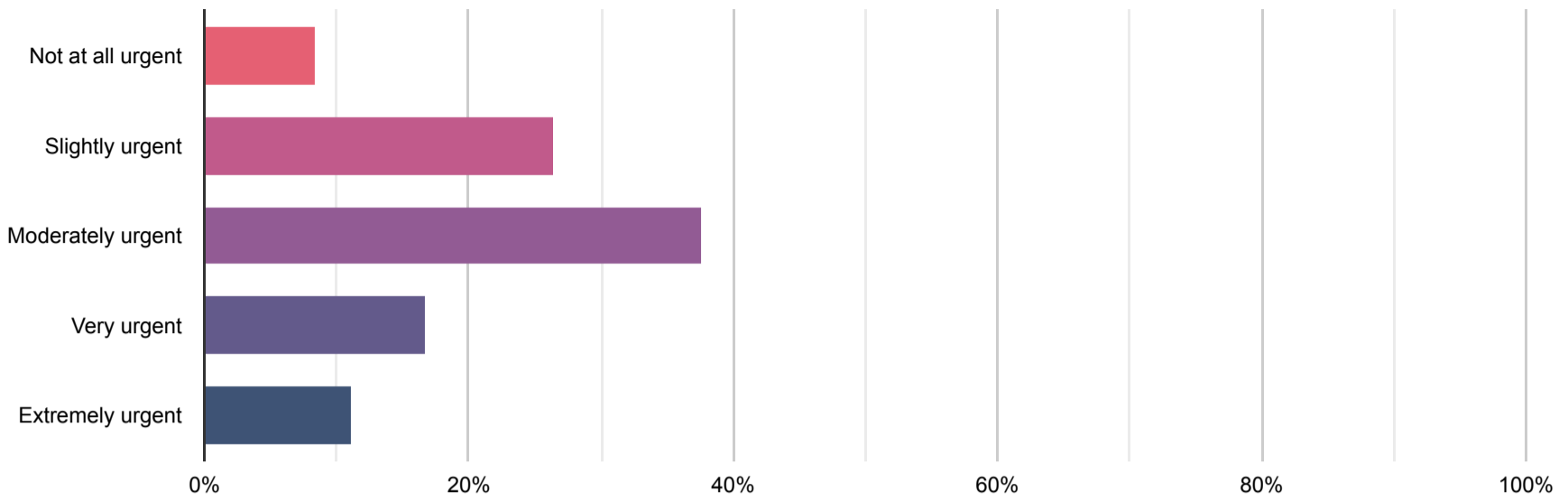
